The following is a check-list to assist you in the registration process.

July $30^{th} \sim 9:00 \text{ AM to } 12:00 \text{ PM}$

July $31^{st} \sim 4:00 \text{ PM to } 8:00 \text{ PM}$
You will need to register your student through iParent on the district website (<u>www.matsuk12.us</u>). We have lap-
top computers set up in the front office to assist you with this step.
For students new to the District, or coming from Home School, you will need your child's immunization record, or
a current Religious Exemption, notarized and signed after July 1, 2014. You will also need to have a copy of your
student's birth certificate. Our School Nurse will be checking all immunizations and Religious Exemptions and students
will not be allowed to attend school until these requirements are met. Please provide this documentation
to the front office staff.
For returning students who have a Religious Exemption, this must be renewed, notarized and signed after July
1, 2014, but prior to the first day of school. Our School Nurse will be checking all immunizations and Religious
Exemptions and students will not be allowed to attend school until these requirements are met. Please
provide this documentation to the office staff.
For those parents registering a kindergartener, please note your child needs to have a TB test no sooner than 6
months prior to starting school. If your kindergartner has not had a TB test, the school nurse will be giving them within
the first couple of months of school starting.

All parents will need to either pay their student's Supply Fee, or submit a Request for Scholarship during on-site
registration. Please note our school utilizes high quality, specialized supplies in order to optimize your student's school
experience. We buy these supplies in bulk to save on the expense and to spare you the hassle of trying to find the correct
supplies. To offset this expense, we request a supply fee of \$100.00 per student, per year, payable either in full or half for
the first semester (due in August) and half for the second semester (due in January). We are happy to offer you a
convenient "school cash" online service where you can pay online using your credit card. Ms. Vanessa
will also be accepting the fees or scholarship requests in the front office.
Fill out the School Assembly 2015-2016 student permission slip and return it to the front office.
BPG (Birchtree Parent Guild) will provide all parents with information and forms regarding your 36 hour per family participation commitment per year.
Review the Birchtree Family Guide and Attendance Policy. Return the signature page to the front office before
leaving registration. We recommend keeping the Family Guide as a reference at home. A copy of this guide can also be
