

A special thanks to some special visitors-

Kim Snyde-Vine and Bente Goldstien first visited our community in its infancy, before our building was even completed. This week, they returned to an older, wiser Birchtree. Initially, Kim and Bente helped with developing our faculty's speech work, classroom, and with enlivening the Waldorf curriculum. At that time only one of the 14 class teachers was Waldorf trained.

Many of them spent their afternoons learning to play choroi flutes, to draw forms, and to knit. Three and one half years later, all 13 remaining teachers have not only received Waldorf certification, but are also working on Master's degrees in Waldorf education.

This past week. Kim has visited each classroom, teaching speech and recitation with expertise that few in the Waldorf movement possess.

Bente, originally from Norway, is a long time Waldorf teacher who runs a farm program for children in Wisconsin. Her expertise encompasses the study of children's drawing, the proprioceptive needs of children, and the benefits of providing students with purposeful work.

Both Kim and Bente have added greatly to the growth of our school , and we wholeheartedly thank them.
